

CARMEL FEAST 2023



The Feast of the Lady of Mount Carmel which is on 16th July was celebrated in school, with great devotion. A special assembly was conducted to mark this annual event. The assembly started with a prayer dance, invoking the blessings of our Lady. The students also spoke about how Carmelites have been known for their deep devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, holding Mother Mary as a model for prayer, contemplation and dedication to God.

The primary school students presented a skit “**Walking in her Footsteps**” which reflected the virtues of Mother Mary, the Mother of Carmel. The skit was a juxtaposition of a mother (human character) to the Mother of Carmel who exemplified all of her virtues. The virtues which were focused on were love, care, affection, mercy, obedience, prudence, empowerment and recollection. The most striking feature of the skit was the students coming one by one wearing a sash with her virtues written on it. It all came together as a tableau of how Mother Mary appeared on the Mount of Carmel with the virtues surrounding her. To add cherry on the cake, choir sang the song "Pure as Carmel". Students later enjoyed the chocolates distributed in all classes.
