




Her's was a devout and prayerful family.

Love for prayer and for the poor was instilled in all the five children right from their childhood.



Sophie took the name Sister Veronica of the Passion.




A Congregation is born: Saint Joseph's Carmel Bayonne, France, July 16 1868

PROMOTION POLICY FOR CLASS IX

A student should secure 33% in the aggregate in all subjects to be declared as passed and promoted.

In case a student does not pass in the Annual Exam, Compartment Exam will be conducted.

A student can appear in a Compartment Exam in not more than two failing subjects.

Compartment Exam will be conducted only once.

In order to be declared "successful" in a Compartment Exam, a student must secure 33% marks in the subject(s) in which she has taken the Compartment Exam.

A student who fails to pass in the Compartment Exam will be detained in the same class during the next session.

Important Instructions class VIII & IX





- The text book should be read minutely and thoroughly as CBSE focuses on close reading of the subject content.
- 75 % attendance is compulsory.
- Please ensure that your ward studies regularly at home.
- Assignments and projects should be submitted on time.





- Internal assessment which includes multiple assessment, Subject enrichment, portfolio etc should be submitted on time.
- Internal assessments carry a lot of weightage.
- In order to be declared pass, a student must secure 33% marks in each of the subjects and in aggregate.



- In case a student is absent due to ill health during examination, the parents should give a written application to the Principal citing the reason for the absence.
- This must be followed by a medical certificate from a registered

medical practitioner within 3 days.





- Inform the class teacher and Admin Office immediately in case of a change in your address and telephone numbers.
- No student is allowed to carry a cell phone to school. If found, the cell phone will be confiscated.
- In case of an emergency, the parent should send an application addressed to the Principal citing the reasons for carrying the mobile phone to school. Students should deposit their phones in the Principal's office which will be returned after school hours.



- We discourage students from possessing, carrying or wearing expensive items to school.
- Nail polish, colouring of hair, highlighting hair will be taken as violation of school rules.
- Parents are requested to monitor your ward and ration their time spent on the net.
- Kindly note school timings are from 7.15 a.m. to 1.35 p.m. Students travelling by private transport are requested to ensure that they reach school in due time.
